



## Medication Refill Policy

**Carolina Surgery Patients,**

Help us to help you! We request your assistance to make sure you have appropriate medication.

**\*\* If you are contracted with a pain management group, you must notify our staff at the time of your visit.**

**\*\*Please plan ahead, NO medication refills or medication changes will be made after normal operating hours, weekends or holidays.**

Appropriate prescription medication will be provided at the time your hospital discharge. This prescription should be sufficient until your post-op appointment.

If you have problems with the medication, call our office to discuss this issue with the nurse.

Our staff at Carolina Surgery needs to have 48 hours advance notice for any prescription refill request, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**DO NOT** wait until you are down to 1-2 pills. Remember that your refill request may be delayed up to 48 hours.

**If you need medication refills, ASK AT THE TIME OF YOUR VISIT. Narcotic prescriptions must be written and can not be faxed or called in. It will save your doctor time and you will not have to return to the office.**
